Chief Bader reported that the truck committee had reviewed the three bids received for the new tanker truck and that the bid submitted by Mid America Fire & Safety, LLC was the lowest responsive bid. The committee recommended that bid be accepted.

Mr. Gaither made a motion to accept the truck committee's recommendation to conditionally accept Mid America Fire & Safety, LLC bid subject to attorney approval of an acceptable purchase agreement. The motion received a second and was passed 4-0. Mr.

Mr. Gaither made a subsequent motion, also seconded, to appoint Chief Bader as the designated authorized agent of the District with respect to change orders, delivery and inspection/acceptance of the tanker truck and to authorize Chief Bader to obtain a performance bond if necessary to protect the interests of the District. The motion was passed 4-0.
