Mr. Pulliam reported that the District had reached agreement with Mid America Fire & Safety, LLC for the purchase of the tanker truck. Mr. Pulliam further explained that since the agreement was entered into in 2016 to be performed in 2017 the Board would need to encumber the addition appropriation amount approved by the Floyd County Council in order to pay for the truck and the associated equipment.

Mr. Moody sponsored **Resolution 2016-6** to encumber funds appropriated for the tanker truck purchase from the 2016 budget into the 2017 budget, which received a second, and was adopted by a unanimous vote.
